Chateau Gracht is a multi-award-winning private clinic for psychotherapy and psychosomatic medicine in Erftstadt. The interior architecture, designed by the interior architect Sylvia Leydecker, translates the historic fabric of the listed castle into a contemporary healing environment. Set in the highly unusual surroundings of a former castle, this clinic – which treats approximately 80 private patients – combines a comfortable atmosphere with specialized therapy to heal the mind. Generous daylighting, circadian lighting, and multi-sensory, carefully coordinated materials create spaces of calm, protection, and comfort. The design combines emotional presence with a clear, modern formal language, subtly yet consistently supporting the therapeutic impact of the medical services. Tradition and contemporary healthcare design enter into a precise, forward-looking dialogue.
